

What do our Beneficiaries receive?

If your application is successful, you will receive...

- Regular payments, currently £1,200 per annum, paid in quarterly instalments of £300, directly into your nominated bank account. Payments are made in March, June, September and December.

Please note that we follow Department of Work and Pension guidance in awarding any payments. Charitable payments are likely to be disregarded when assessing income for means tested benefits and income tax.

- Regular visits every 12-18 months, by one of our Caseworkers, at which time a review of your current financial situation will be undertaken.
- An Annual Newsletter, Annual Review and other correspondence as appropriate.

You can contact the Society during office hours with any queries or information. A short message can be left on our 24 hour answering machine and we will return your call as soon as possible.
